# Accept Blue Payment Gateway – Installation Manual for OpenCart 4.x

Here is a **proper**, **step-by-step installation manual** for the **Accept Blue Payment Gateway** extension for **OpenCart 4.x**. This guide assumes that the extension is provided in a standard .ocmod.zip format, which is typical for OpenCart 4 extensions.

## **Prerequisites**

- 1. OpenCart Version: Make sure you're using OpenCart 4.x.
- 2. Admin Access: You need full administrator access to the OpenCart admin panel.
- 3. **Extension File:** Ensure you have the accept\_blue.ocmod.zip file from the official source or developer.

## Step-by-Step Installation Guide


## Step 1: Upload Files via FTP

- 1. Extract the extension package on your local computer.
- 2. Locate the admin/ and system/ folders inside the package.
- 3. Use an FTP client (e.g., FileZilla) or your hosting file manager.
- 4. Upload:
  - o The contents of the admin/ folder to your server's /admin/ directory
  - o The contents of the system/ folder to your server's /system/ directory

Do not overwrite existing files unless they are part of the Accept Blue extension. Always back up your site before making changes.


#### Step 2: Log in to OpenCart Admin

- Go to your OpenCart admin panel.
- Example: https://yourstore.com/admin
- Enter your admin credentials.




# Step 3: Upload the Extension

1. Go to Extensions > Installer.




2. Click the **Upload** button.



- 3. Select the accept\_blue.ocmod.zip file from your computer.
- 4. Wait until you see a **success message** indicating that the extension has been uploaded.

# **Step 4: Install the Extension Module**


1. Go to Extensions > Extensions.




2. In the dropdown, select "Payments".



3. Find Accept Blue in the list.



4. Click the green **Install (+)** button.




5. Once installed, click the **Edit** ( ) button to configure it.

Here you need to enter API credentials and other necessary settings.




- Tokenization Key: Provided by Accept Blue
- Source Key: Provided by Accept Blue
- Pin code: Provided by Accept Blue
- Tokenization Key (Sandbox): Provided by Accept Blue

- Source Key (Sandbox): Provided by Accept Blue
- Pin code (Sandbox): Provided by Accept Blue
- Order Statuses: Set appropriate status for successful and failed payments

#### **Payment Method Configuration Settings**


The following settings are available individually for each supported payment method: **Credit Card**, **Apple Pay**, and **Google Pay**.

# **Credit Card Settings**



- Transaction Mode Define the mode of transaction (e.g., Test or Live).
- **Transaction Method** Specify the transaction type (e.g., Authorization, Sale).
- **Total** Minimum order total required for this payment method to be available.
- Order Status The default order status after a successful transaction.
- **Geo Zone** Restrict this payment method to specific geographic zones.
- **Status** Enable or disable the payment method.
- **Sort Order** The display order relative to other payment methods at checkout.

#### **Google Pay Settings**



- Google Pay Merchant ID Your unique Google Pay merchant identifier.
- Merchant Name The name displayed to users during checkout.
- **Transaction Mode** Define the mode of transaction (e.g., Test or Live).
- **Transaction Method** Specify the transaction type (e.g., Authorization, Sale).
- **Total** Minimum order total required for this payment method to be available.
- Order Status The default order status after a successful transaction.
- **Geo Zone** Restrict this payment method to specific geographic zones.
- Status Enable or disable the payment method.
- Sort Order The display order relative to other payment methods at checkout.

#### **Apple Pay Settings**




- Apple Pay Merchant ID Your unique Apple Pay merchant identifier.
- **Merchant Name** The name displayed to users during checkout.
- **Transaction Mode** Define the mode of transaction (e.g., Test or Live).
- **Transaction Method** Specify the transaction type (e.g., Authorization, Sale).
- **Total** Minimum order total required for this payment method to be available.
- Order Status The default order status after a successful transaction.
- **Geo Zone** Restrict this payment method to specific geographic zones.
- **Status** Enable or disable the payment method.
- **Sort Order** The display order relative to other payment methods at checkout.

Make sure you test API credentials in sandbox mode before going live.

# **Step 6: Modify Cache & Refresh Modifications**

1. Go to Extensions > Modifications.



2. Click the **Refresh** ( ) button in the top right.



## **Step 7: Test the Payment Method**

1. Place a test order on your storefront.

- 2. Go through the checkout process and ensure the **Accept Blue** payment method is displayed.
- 3. Complete the order and verify if:
  - o The payment goes through
  - o The order status updates correctly
  - o Notifications/emails are sent if configured
